



What to expect from Voter's School of Dance during the COVID-19 pandemic...

In a time when things are constantly changing, you can still count on the same Voter's School of Dance... We continue to be both JOYFUL and CAUTIOUS about our time spent in the studio with our wonderful dance families. We've been going above and beyond to ensure a clean, safe and welcoming environment for our students to continue their dance education.

Friendly Safety Protocol Reminders!

- If you, your child, or anyone you have been in contact with has been diagnosed or experienced symptoms of COVID-19, please **STAY HOME**.
- When arriving at Voter's, dancers should be dressed and ready for class. Please bring water (only) with dancer's name marked on it and a dance bag with necessary items. No food allowed.
- One parent is welcome to drop-off dancer. Both dancer and parent must wear masks and practice social distancing when dropping off. Please arrive 5 minutes early for class. We ask that you walk your child to the front entrance (near the nail salon) of the studio for drop-off purposes. Once your child has his/her temperature checked, sanitizes hands and walks into the dance room, we ask that you leave.
- All studios are taped off in 6-foot squares in order to maintain proper social distancing recommendations. Class sizes are limited in order to achieve a proper physical distance as well. Once your dancer selects a square, students are allowed to take off their mask to dance. Hand sanitizer is available in both studios and lobby.
- We are not allowed to have parents congregating in the lobby area due to COVID-19 space restrictions.
- After class you are welcome to pick-up your child in the hallway; older dancers will be escorted out by his/her dance instructor. Please be ready to pick-up your child at the landing (near the Army Barracks). We do not want our dancers wandering around the parking lot looking for you.
- Classes are scheduled so as to allow time for cleaning/disinfecting and allow students to finish and leave the studio before the next set of students arrive. At the end of each class, teachers will clean barres, shelves, door handles, stereo equipment, etc in every studio.

We are following New Hampshire's COVID-19 guidelines. Our goal has always been to educate and share our love of dance and in a safe, secure and nurturing environment.
